

Welcome to 39,000 acres of pure joy. Watts Bar Lake is a year-round playground for water sports enthusiasts and fishermen. Enjoy a peaceful paddle in a picturesque cove, or race across the water behind a speedboat. Splash the day away on a pontoon boat with friends, or catch your fill of striper, bass or crappie. Use Watts Bar as your launching point to chart a new course.

Lakeside, you'll find restaurants that offer great food, live music and spectacular sunset views. Settle into a prime spot for watching great blue herons, osprey and bald eagles. Explore 10 lakeside public parks and wildlife areas with miles of trails, campgrounds, golf and disc golf courses. Several marinas, boat launches and fishing piers provide additional water access.


















Come Explore the Great Outdoors

Follow trails along ridges and through forests, stroll along the lake, camp under the stars or picnic in a park. In Roane County, Tennessee, hike and bike trails where wildlife and wildflowers thrive. Camp alongside the sparkling waters of Watts Bar Lake. Play a round of golf (or disc golf). Roane County is a beautiful stop along the Tennessee RiverLine, where trails and pathways connect us to all of the recreational options along the Tennessee River.

Explore hotspots for birding, stroll through lakeside parks and wetlands, take the kids to a splash pad or playground, or kick back and enjoy live music at one of our outdoor concerts. Park your RV at Caney Creek to enjoy boat rentals and other amenities. Bike or walk the Ladd Greenway, fish from the pier or picnic at a pavilion. Join the trail runners and mountain bikers on the Rockwood Forest Trails. We even have great places for your four-legged friends to play.
















Immerse Yourself in History

From 1801 to the secrets of World War II, Roane County has a unique and fascinating history. Explore Fort Southwest Point, Tennessee's only pioneer-era fort standing on its original location. Spend the day at the Historic Roane County Courthouse and learn how Kingston was the State Capital for a day. Walk the cobblestone streets of Harriman's Cornstalk Heights Historic District, where more than 100 grand Victorian buildings are on the National Register. See the remarkable Temperance Building, the Art Deco Princess Theatre and the Carnegie Library.

Delve into the amazing mysteries of the Secret City of Oak Ridge and the Manhattan Project. Named an American World War II Heritage City, this area was a hotbed of scientific achievement. K-25 Overlook provides a good introduction to the monumental effort that changed the world forever. Numerous sites tell the story as part of the Manhattan Project National Historical Park.





Stay in Roane County

In addition to reliable hotel chains, Roane County has a variety of comfortable and unique short-term rentals, campgrounds and inns. The Whitestone Country Inn, a "top ten most romantic inn," sits on 600 acres on Watts Bar Lake with views of the Smoky Mountains. Caney Creek and Riley Creek campgrounds offer great spots to park your RV right along the banks of Watts Bar Lake. The new Rockwood Marina & RV Resort features nearby trails for mountain biking, hiking and running, with easy access to local restaurants and shops. Or, for more privacy, rent a lakeside cottage, cabin or executive estate.
